Title of the practice

The process of creating a common flood hazard and risk map for the Sotla / Vonarje river area



Detailed description of the practice

During the Flood-Wise project it was envisaged that the inventory assessment of the existence of flood risk and hazard maps will be made. During the assessment it was found out, that there are no existing maps either on Slovenian or on Croatian side of the Sotla river basin. So the preparation of maps started practically from scratch and involved the inputs from both project partners. From this case the benefits are also for both water authorities (Slovenian and Croatian), which can transfer this practice to other border rivers between Slovenia and Croatia.

Evidence of success

Prepared transnational (cross-border) flood risk and hazard maps. It is important, that the creation of flood hazard and risk maps is monitored and accepted by both project partners (in Slovenia and Croatia) which was not the case in past.
